Organization Description

Nueva Esperanza is a Latino faith-based community development corporation. They are an experienced regional and national intermediary. They have been a leader in reaching across regional, cultural, and sector boundaries within the Latino and Hispanic communities in the US.

Project Description

The Hispanic Capacity Project proposes to strengthen the organizational, management, program, and resource development capacities of 605 local Hispanic FBOs and CBOs in eight regions of the country. They will offer training and technical assistance appropriate for improving the organization based on their Continuum of Capacity.

Geographic Scope of Project

The project will serve Latino FBO/CBOs in 8 regions of the country, and over 3 years will ultimately include:

- Southern California
- Metropolitan New York
- Southern/Central Florida
- Delaware and LeHigh Valleys, Southern New Jersey
- Midwest US
- Seattle, Washington
- South Central Texas
- Metropolitan Washington, DC

Sub-Awards

Nueva Esperanza, Inc. will provide \$500,000 in year one to \$1,000,000 in year three in sub-awards annually to up to 49 FBOs and CBOs. The project will grant two types of sub-awards to participating FBOs and CBOs. The Capacity Development Fund is intended to improve specific capacities. The Strategic Leverage Fund is for qualified organizations presenting a plan to leverage other funding from public or private sources for their work.

Project Objectives

1. To strengthen the capacity of 605 Latino FBOs and CBOs in 8 regions of the United States.
2. To promote the adoption and use of their "Continuum of Capacity" framework for appropriate organizational infrastructure.
3. To grant sub-awards in each of the 8 regions to build specific organizational capacities and leverage funding from other sources.

Project Strategies

- Provide workshops in each region using an established curriculum that covers many of the key areas for building capacity in community organizations.
- Provide specialized technical assistance delivered by Regional Coordinators and Regional technical assistance consultants.
